Report on problems and unfinished business in Bulgaria to be presented

Sofia. A report on the problems and unfinished business in Bulgaria, which directly affect citizens' life and are not included in the EC's benchmarks, will be presented on Sunday in the Radisson hotel in Sofia.

On the background of the EC's report two and half years after joining the EU Bulgaria has done too little to reform essential areas, such as social sphere, healthcare, education and others, the report reads. Amid a global crisis this is a potential risk of destabilization of the political system and undermines people's confidence in institutions, analysts warn.

The report is part of a research project called Unfinished Business of the Fifth Enlargement Countries and developed by the European Policies Initiative.
