No respect for order /ROUNDUP/

A few incidents occurred on Tuesday afternoon in Bulgaria. An anonymous male voice made an empty bomb threat in the northern town of Gorna Oryahovitsa. In Sofia a young woman was shooting with an air gun at police officers. The day also saw lack of respect for road safety rules. Eight people were injured in two serious crashes in the southern city of Plovdiv and capital Sofia.

Gorna Oryahovitsa: Gorna Oryahovitsa railway station was closed for more than five hours after an anonymous male voice called the station at 2:40 p.m. Bulgarian time and said a bomb would go off at 6:00 p.m. The transport police, National Railway Infrastructure Company staff and police evacuated the passengers from the waiting room and cordoned off the area. The trains were not arriving before the station, but at the end of the platforms. Tickets were sold in the trains. The railway station was reopened at 7:00 p.m. after no explosive device was found. Since the beginning of 2009 the railway system has been subject to systematic telephone terrorism. Within a week solely, between 10 January and 16 January 2009 Dimitrovgrad, Sliven, Koprivshitsa railway stations and Sofia-Varna train were threatened with a bomb. On 22 January 2009 Plovdiv railway station was closed because of an explosive device warning. Fortunately, no explosive devices were found in all of the above mentioned cases.

Sofia: On Tuesday at about 5:00 p.m. Bulgarian time the police were alerted about a shooting in Sofia's residential district of Krasna Polyana. According to the initial information a 16-year-old girl was shooting with an air gun from the balcony of her family's apartment on the third floor. A police officer, who was patrolling the region at that time, was hurt in his back by a few pellets. He sustains bruises and will receive medical treatment. Police officers are now talking with the girl's father.

Shortly before that three people were injured in a collision between two cars on Sofia ring road on Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. The National Medical Coordination Center said that a 21-year-old man, a 57-year-old man and a 42-year-old woman were injured. They were hospitalized in Military Medical Academy in Sofia and are out of danger.

Plovdiv: Five people were injured in a collision between two cars in the southern city of Plovdiv on Tuesday afternoon. The National Medical Coordination Center told FOCUS News Agency details about the injured passengers.

An 80-year-old man who was driving one of the cars sustains a chest bruise and an elbow sprain. A nine-year-old boy suffers a face bruise and a jaw fracture. A two-year-old girl sustains a bruise and hematoma. From the other car – two men aged 64 and 46 suffer head bruises and commotion.

They all have been hospitalized in the city of Plovdiv.
