Sofia. The traffic along roads nationwide is normal. No traffic jams, lines of vehicles or stranded cars have been reported, major Krasimir Kostov, spokesman for the Traffic Police, told Focus News Agency. It is snowing slightly in Northern Bulgaria and on high grounds.

There is a danger from falling stones at the Troyan-Karnare Pass, the Iskar and Kresna gorges, and along the roads Sofia-Samokov, Mezdra-Botevgrad, Asenovgrad-Smolyan, Yugovo-Laki, Krichim-Devin, the region of Koznitsa, Haskovo-Kardzhali-Momchilgrad-Makaza, Beli Plast-Stremsi, Chiflik-Chernoochene.

Freight vehicles should travel without trailers and semi-trailers along Shipka and Predela Passes and Batak-Dospat road.

A collision between two cars caused traffic jam close to the city of Stara Zagora, at the turn-off for Trakia highway. The line of vehicles was almost two kilometres long. The crashed cars were taken off the road and the traffic got back to normal.

Greek border police at Ilinden-Exochi checkpoint do not let Bulgarian cars cross the border if they are not ready for winter driving.

The snow cover at Gyueshevo border checkpoint is between 15cm and 20cm. The roads have been cleared. Motorists should be very careful in the region of Strazhata, Cherna Niva and along the road to Gyueshevo.
